

Discipline - 2:12 Heb. 12:28-29 -Since we receive a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire.

Dependence - 2:13 I Corinthians 15:10 -But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me was not in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them, though it was not I, but the grace of God that is with me.

Six Distinctives of Boone Worthies, as we walk together in an obedience worthy of the sacred trust of the Gospel: III. Acceptance - 2:14 Numbers 14:1-2 -The all the people raised a loud cry, and the people wept that night. And all the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron.

Romans 15:5-7 -Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with one another according to Christ Jesus, so that with one accord you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, accept one another, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.

Six Distinctives of Boone Worthies, as we walk together in an obedience worthy of the sacred trust of the Gospel:

IV. Purity - 2:15

Romans 12:1-2 -I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Daniel 6:3-5 -

Daniel became distinguished above all the other high officials and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him. And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom. Then the high officials and the satraps sought to find a ground for complaint against Daniel with regard to the kingdom, but they could find no ground for complaint or any fault, because he was faithful, and no error or fault was found in him. Then these men said, "We shall not find any ground for complaint against this Daniel unless we find it in connection with the law of his God."

John 15:11 -These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.
