COVID Stats:

- 31% reported symptoms of anxiety or depression disorders
- 26% trauma/stressor-related disorder symptoms
- 13% started or increased substance abuse
- 11% seriously considered suicide; ages 18-24, 26%!
- Overall, 41% reported at least one adverse mental or behavioral health condition; ages 18-24, 80% (CDC, 8/14/20)

I. The Impossible Command: **Do Not be Anxious! II. The Improbable Solution: Prayer** Matthew 6:8 -The Father knows what you need before you ask Him

II. The Improbable Solution: Prayer Matthew 6:31-32 -Do not be anxious, saying, "What shall we eat?" or "What shall we drink?" or "What shall we wear?" for the world seeks all these things, but your heavenly Father knows that you need them all.

II. The Improbable Solution: Prayer I Peter 5:7 -Cast your cares upon Him, for He cares for you. **II. The Improbable Solution: Prayer** Romans 8:31-32 -What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

III. The Incomparable Promise: Peace Isaiah 26:3 -God will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on Him, because he trusts in Him. **III. The Incomparable Promise: Peace** John 14:27 -"My peace I give to you; my peace I leave with you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

III. The Incomparable Promise: Peace Psalm 55:22 -Cast your burden upon the Lord, and he will sustain you. He will never allow the righteous to be shaken.

IV. The Daily Practice: Think Healthy Thoughts II Corinthians 10:5 -Take every thought captive to the obedience of **Christ!**
