- 1. They will kick us out. 6:2 social and emotional persecution

- II. The Explanation for PersecutionC. Why do they persecute us? *HATE*
 - 1. They hate us vs. 18a
 - a) We are not of them.
 We do not belong.
 We are citizens of heaven.
 - 2. They hate our Lord
 - vs. 18b, 21, and 23

- II. The Explanation for PersecutionC. Why do they persecute us? *HATE*
 - 2. They hate our Lord
 - vs. 18b, 21, and 23
 - a) Jesus is not their Lord. They don't belong to him. He is not their shepherd. He is not their vine that they get life from. He is light and exposes their evil deeds, and they love darkness rather than light.

- II. The Explanation for PersecutionC. Why do they persecute us? *HATE*
 - 3. They hate our Lord's Father vs. 23
 - a) Persecution is ultimately an attack against the heavenly Father. Jesus makes this clear in Chapter. 8:39-45. When the Jews wanted to kill Jesus in Chapter 8, Jesus told them it was because God was not their father & their allegiance & devotion was to their true father Satan. Eph. 2:1-2.

III.The Exhortation during Persecution Jesus knows that persecution brings with it certain temptations. Two temptations I believe Jesus addresses in this passage.

- 1) Shutting up 2) Shaking loose.
 - A. We must remain a faithful follower of Jesus is the midst of persecution, because Satan would love to shake us loose Vs. 16:1
