Luke 22:61-62 -

And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. And Peter remembered the saying of the Lord, how he had said to him, "Before the rooster crows today, you will deny me three times." And he went out and wept bitterly.

I. Those Who Follow May Fail

II Cor. 7:10 –

Godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death.

II. Those Who Fail May be Forgiven

Matt. 26:31-33 -

Then Jesus said to them, "You will all fall away because of me this night. For it is written, 'I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.' But after I am raised up, I will go before you to Galilee." Peter answered him, "Though they all fall away because of you, I will never fall away."

II. Those Who Fail May be Forgiven

I John 1:9 –

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Jeremiah 1:5 –

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations."
