

Col 3:22-4:1 –

"Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. Whatever you do, work at it heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality.

1 Cor. 7:17 –

Only let each person lead the life that the Lord has assigned to him, and to which God has called him. This is my rule in all the churches.

Instead, think of the gospel as a set of glasses through which you "look" at everything else in the world. Christians in business will see... profit as only one of several bottom lines; and they will work passionately for any kind of enterprise that serves the common good. The Christian writer can constantly be showing the destructiveness of making something besides God into the central thing, even without mentioning God directly." ~ Timothy Keller

Our faith doesn't dictate WHAT we do for work, but HOW we work?


