

Revelation 21:8 -

As for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death. **II. Motivations to Fearless Proclamation**

A. Call - Vs. 1

II Corinthians 5:20 -We are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

II. Motivations to Fearless Proclamation B. Promise - Vs. 1 John 17:3 -This is eternal life, that we may know Him. **Colossians 3:4 -**Christ, who is our life.

Isaiah 55:1-3 -
