A. Flee Immorality - Vs. 22

We are to flee “sexual immorality”

- **I Corinthians 6:18**

We are to flee “idolatry”

- **I Corinthians 10:14**

We are to flee the love of money

- **I Timothy 6:11**

John 7:37-38 -

If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.
Whoever believes in Me, as the Scripture has said,
“Out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water.”

Proverbs 17:14 -

The beginning of strife is like letting out water, so quit before the quarrel breaks out.

Proverbs 20:3 -

It is an honor for a man to keep aloof from strife, but every fool will be quarreling.

Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.
