I. We See the Glory of the Royal Son - 27:27-44, 54

II Samuel 7:12-13 -

When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your seed after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

I. We See the Glory of the Royal Son - 27:27-44, 54

Psalm 2:6-7 -

"As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill." I will tell of the decree: The LORD said to me, "You are my Son; today I have begotten you."

II. We See the Glory of the Suffering Servant- 27:45-50

Psalm 22 -

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?...All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads; "He trusts in the LORD; let him deliver him; let him rescue him, for he delights in him!"...They have pierced my hands and feet— I can count all my bones—they stare and gloat over me; they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

II. We See the Glory of the Suffering Servant- 27:45-50

Galatians 3:13 -

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree."

II Corinthians 5:21 -

For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

III. We See the Glory of the Great High Priest - 27:51

Hebrews 6:19-20 -

We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner place behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

III. We See the Glory of the Great High Priest - 27:51

Hebrews 10:19-22 -

Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

IV. We See the Glory of Our Resurrection Hope - 27:52-53

Ezekiel 37:7, 12 -

And as I prophesied, there was a sound, and behold, an earthquake, and the bones came together... "Prophecy, and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord your God: Behold, I will open your graves and raise you from your graves."
