Six Gospel Words from the Cross:

I. Deity - Vs. 17-22

Rev. 5:9-13 -

And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth." Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels,...

Rev. 5:9-13 –

...numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever!"

Rev. 19:16 –

"And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "King of Kings and Lord of Lords."

John 1:1, 14 –

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Hebrews 2:17 –

He had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

Psalm 22:18 –

They divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

III. Sovereignty - Vs. 23-25, 28-30

Luke 24:25-27 –

And he said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

III. Sovereignty - Vs. 23-25, 28-30

Psalm 69:21 –

For my thirst they gave me sour wine to drink.

IV. Compassion - Vs. 25-27

John 10:11 –

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

V. Substitution - Vs. 30

John 10:17-18 –

For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from my Father."

V. Substitution - Vs. 30

Hebrews 2:17 –

He had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

Hebrews 9:26 –

He has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.
